### **Parking Advisory Committee**

#### **Article 1: Purpose**

The Parking Advisory Committee is a campus-wide committee established to provide advice to the President for on campus and transportation policies, procedures, services and programs, including:

1. Use and allocation of parking space and facilities.
2. Proposed changes and adjustments to the parking permit fee schedule (Category III fee) and the parking violation penalty schedule (Category IV fee).
3. The development of long term strategies to maintain existing parking facilities, acquire and construct new parking facilities.
4. Develop and enhance existing alternate methods of transportation programs for students and employees.

#### **Background**

In fiscal year 1995-96, the CSU Parking System was decentralized to the 23 campuses as part of the Chancellor's objective to increase accountability at the campus levels and to improve the alignment of responsibility and authority for the university programs (Coded Memo BF95-09).

The CSU Parking System Task Force recommendations for decentralization included,

"...campuses should be responsible for annual operations, maintenance and repair, future new construction projects, establishing necessary reserves, and payment of system wide expenses."

## **Parking Advisory Committee Charter Version 1**

Parking revenues derived from parking fines and forfeitures are restricted in use for (1) the development, enhancement, and operations of alternate methods of transportation programs for students and employees or (2) the administration of the parking fines and forfeiture programs.

### **Article 2: Membership**

The membership of the Parking Advisory Committee shall include:

Term	Membership
1 Year	President or Designee of ASCMA
1 Year	One appointed by the Corps Commander
2 Years	A designee appointed by the Vice President for Academic Affairs
2 Years	A designee appointed by the Vice President for Student Affairs
2 Years	A designee appointed by the Vice President for A & F
2 Years	Chair of the Academic Senate or an appointee
	Chief of Police
	The Director of Facilities Planning
	The Director of Facilities Operations
	The Director of Conference & Events

**Article 2, Section 1: Term**

With the exception of student members, no members shall be appointed to two (2) consecutive terms.

**Article 2, Section 2: Chairperson**

The Committee shall appoint the Chairperson.

**Article 2, Section 3: Quorum**

Nine (9) member: five (5) would be quorum.

**Article 2, Section 4: Meeting Notes**
