

On-Call Team Standing Orders

1. Follow all instructions outlined in the Student Handout and Regulations Governing the Corps of Cadets unless superseded by the following. Follow all Night Orders and posted signs at the watch stations. All watch personnel must read and initial their understanding of the Standing Orders and the Night Orders.

2. **Purpose:** The Divisional On-Call Team will be available to respond to (1) vacancies in the watch bill; (2) urgent repairs and maintenance on TSGB; and (3) MARSEC level changes. The Team may only be recalled by the VPMP & SD or his designee.

3. **Composition:**
 - a. Each On-Call Team will consist of four Deck and four Engine cadets and four cadets in the campus/facilities watch rotation from the duty division.

 - b. Each Team should consist of members from all four year groups.

4. **Change in Watch Routine:**
 - a. Night Mates, Night Engineers, and Campus Duty Officer shall have the information necessary to recall the watch with proper authorization.

 - b. Night Mates and Night Engineers should utilize the watch section to assist with special projects and functional tasks, such as pulling tank covers, loading life jackets, etc.

 - c. Night Mates, Night Engineers, and Campus Duty Officers should ensure watch areas, quarterdeck and engine room, are cleaned by the watch.

 - d. If a recall for MARSEC level change is required during the academic day, licensed faculty members will be used until the completion of classes.

 - e. All On-Call cadets will be required to respond to vacancies in their specific watch bills.

 - f. All On-Call cadets will be required to respond to MARSEC level changes on TSGB or the facility.

5. **Requirements:**
 - a. Each On-Call Team cadet MUST report to the Corps Office in the Uniform of the Day between 0730 and 1100 to return the duty pagers. Oncoming On-Call Team cadets must report to the Corps Office between 1100 and 1230 to sign out their respective pagers.

 - b. Each On-Call Team cadet MUST be available for recall during the entire duty period.

- c. Each On-Call Team cadet MUST be able to return to the campus within two hours of being called, unless commute requirements prevent such. Upon being recalled, it is the recalled cadet's responsibility to advise of a delay in arrival due to commuting requirements.
- d. Once paged, the On-Call cadet should contact the Quarterdeck at 654-1359 for deck cadets; EOS at 654-1312 for engine cadets; and Corps Office at 654-1195 for all campus/facility watch cadets.
- e. Each On-Call Team cadet should expect to be drilled in MARSEC level changes. Due to Security Requirements, there will be mandatory drills of the MARSEC level changes at least quarterly.
- f. If required for a TSGB recall, each On-Call Team cadet should arrive in working uniforms.
- g. If required for a facility recall, each On-Call Team cadet should arrive in the prescribed uniform of the day.
- h. Unavailability for recall shall result in disciplinary action.
- i. When reporting to TSGB, cadets shall be required to be within all Merchant standards, including alcohol blood level content.
