The purpose of this watch is to familiarize cadets who are not in the deck program at CMA with the watches stood by deck cadets on the TS Golden Bear. The following is a list of basic competencies that you should have completed by the end of your utility watch. The Quartermaster should be your primary aid in completing the assigned tasks. As each one is completed have the CWO initial the correct box on the right. Sign and date the form at the bottom when completed. Remember, don't be afraid to ask questions!

CWO's be sure that the utility watch is stood properly, initial that each task has been completed, and sign and date the form at the bottom when completed. Retain the form so the N/M can turn them in to the Corps office in the morning.
