Subject: Important message regarding classes

Dear Cal Maritime cadets and staff,

As of yesterday, March 19, classes which can be migrated to virtual environments and remote learning have begun. Following consultation between the faculty senate executive committee and academic affairs, the following decisions have been made as they relate to the planned academic calendar for the remainder of the spring. These decisions were communicated to faculty by the provost.

- All classes which have been converted to remote instruction will continue in those virtual environments up through and including the regularly-scheduled final exam period that ends on April 28.
- Those classes which could not be converted and are currently suspended will resume as soon as circumstances allow after April 28. Plans are for these in-person courses will be conducted for three plus weeks including final exams with extended hours to maximize instruction time.
- The Cruise will be planned to follow the completion of this tentative schedule.
- March 26-April 5 is spring break for the cadets.

As always, we appreciate your patience and understanding as we work through the many issues that arise daily in these difficult circumstances.
