

Incoming Freshman and Transfer Housing

All incoming freshman (including transfers) will be placed into either the Upper Residence Hall or The Training Ship GOLDEN BEAR (TSGB) depending on the following.

- 1) **Major**- Marine Transportation and all Engine programs will reside for a semester in Upper Residence Hall and a semester on the TSGB for The Freshman Living Learning Program. Business and Global Studies will be in the Upper Residence Hall for the entire year.
- 2) **Company**- Each incoming freshman (including transfers) will be placed into either the Blue or Gold Company by the Leadership Development Office. Company assignments will determine which semester you will be living on the TSGB and which semester you will be living in the Residence Hall.
- 3) **Age**- If the housing department has space in one of the other halls (Lower Residence Hall or McAllister Hall) and you are not of traditional college age you may be chosen to move into these other halls.
- 4) **Priority**-If the Housing Department receives your Housing License Agreement first you will be in the selection process for a water view room in Upper Residence Hall. Please send your housing forms to The Admissions office with your packet and they will get them to the Housing Department.

All incoming freshman (including transfers) will receive a packet in the mail that will provide important information in regards including roommate assignments. The packet will also outline what you can and cannot bring to The Residence Halls/TSGB. This packet will be sent out late July and early August.
