Power of 8's are for Lower Residence Hall only. You can apply only if you have exactly eight people. All members need to be of the same gender due to bathroom space. Power of 8's are granted based on the following factors:

1. Number of cumulative points – points are given to each member of the power of 8 based on their class year. Seniors = 4; Juniors = 3, sophomores = 2, freshman = 1. Class year refers to the anticipated year of graduation and NOT corps change over. Those groups with the highest number of points stand the best chance of being awarded a power of 8.
2. Conduct record of each member
3. Contribution to Housing community
