## • Minutes Review and Approval

## • Rapid Action Groups

- Chair stresses importance of faculty involvement in all these, especially senators will send an email out later today
- President is considering an opt-in corps
  - Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary are finding good levels of support for opt-in corps across campus
    - Would increase enrollment specifically of local community members
    - Senator Simons echoes support, messaging will be helpful
    - Senator Ward echoes support, went to SUNY Maritime herself with an opt-in corps and never saw siloing, etc.
    - Senator Holden echoes support, we already have license and nonlicense students
    - Goal is to be ready for Fall 2024
- Senator Ward brings up how she wants to share thoughts/frustration over how training ship is staffed within one of these working groups and advocate for changes in structure
  - Chair McNie shares that meeting with CSU (CO) HR occurred, and there
    was discussion of how it would work functionally if faculty served as ship
    officers this is biggest hurdle
  - Administrative Finance working group would be best place to go

## • Discontinuation Policy Update

• Back in November this was distributed for feedback – only got one individual feedback – is this ready to forward to next step? Senators agree to move forward.

## • Range Elevation for Lecturers Policy

- From AVP claims this is a senate policy, but discussion clarifies that this is an administrative policy
- o Policy will be circulated to senators for feedback

## • Open Floor

- Senator Holden recommends consistency an email with all documents, links, etc. in one place to remind about what's going on, or perhaps use of Canvas LMS
- o Senator Ward has president mentioned any specific program discontinuation?
  - Chair: No, but for any program expansion it will need to be no-cost
