¹ All students are required to live on campus and have a meal plan, unless an exemption is granted in writing by Housing Department.

² Student may substitute the 15-meal plan. Request for change is due to the Cashier by the second Friday of the semester.

³ Optional user fee. Parking permits are required to park on campus.

⁴ Medical Insurance is mandatory. Student must show proof of valid insurance to the Health Center by the term due date and receive refund of fee. For Fall – 9/15/04. For Spring – 1/25/05. After the deadline insurance is not refundable. Student may choose annual coverage at \$599.00.

⁵ Non-resident fee is charged at \$339 per semester unit, up to a maximum of 15 units for \$5,085 a semester.

⁶ Deposit for Housing is due by May 1st for room reservation.

⁷ TSGB Cruise fee includes food service, lodging & facilities, and transportation costs related to the annual cruise.

⁸ Orientation fee includes Housing and Food Service.

⁹ A \$350 deposit is due by May 1st. Balance to be paid in full directly to CMA Bookstore before Uniform is issued. Business Students & Global Studies Only – balance of initial issue is \$975. For all other students – balance of initial issue is \$1,325.
