1. This fee is subject to adjustment by the CSU Board of Trustees.
2. Medical Insurance is automatically billed for students registered in 6+ units. In order to waive this fee, student must complete a medical insurance waiver form and show proof of valid insurance to the Health Center by the due date. After deadline, insurance is not refundable. Waivers must be renewed each academic year before the Fall semester.
3. Non-resident fee is charged at \$372 per semester unit, up to a maximum of 30 units per academic year (\$11,160).
4. Class fee for administration and instructional review of the program.
5. Fee includes lodging and food service during Orientation.
6. All students are required to live on campus and have a meal plan, unless an exemption is granted in writing by the Housing Department. 15 Meal + FLEX plan is available for Seniors only.
7. Deposit for Housing is due by May 1st for room reservation. This deposit is part of the \$500 Acceptance Deposit.
8. Parking permits are required to park on campus. Motorcycle permits are \$27.00 for the Fall-Spring semester.
9. A \$350 deposit is due by May 1st which is included in the \$500 Acceptance Deposit. Balance of \$1,435 + tax for Marine Transportation students to be paid in full directly to Cal Maritime Bookstore before uniform is issued. Business & Global Studies students, balance is \$1,200 + tax; Engineering students, balance is \$1,330 + tax.
