1. Fee is subject to adjustment by the CSU Board of Trustees.
2. Medical Insurance fee is automatically billed for students registered in 6+ units. Fee may be waived if student submits medical insurance waiver form and provides proof of valid insurance to the Health Center by the published due date. Waivers must be renewed each academic year before the Fall semester. It is the student's responsibility to ensure waiver requests have been received and approved by the Health Center.
3. Non-resident fee is charged at \$372 per semester unit for all units enrolled. This is in addition to the State Univ. Fee.
4. Class fee for administration and instructional review of the program.
5. Fee includes lodging and food service during Orientation.
6. All students are required to live on campus and have a meal plan, unless an exemption is granted in writing by the Housing Department. Flex plan provides 15 Meals / week, plus up to \$195 /semester for additional food purchases.
7. Deposit for Housing is due by May 1st for room reservation. This deposit is part of the \$500 Acceptance Deposit.
8. Parking permits are required to park on campus. Motorcycle permits are \$27 for the Fall-Spring semester.
9. \$350 deposit due by May 1st (part of acceptance deposit). Balance to be paid directly to Cal Maritime Bookstore before uniform is issued. Business & Global Studies students deduct \$130. Sales tax is added to purchase price.
