

Spring 2010 REGISTRATION DATES

All students currently enrolled in the Corps of Cadets have been assigned an “enrollment appointment”, which is a specific day and time that a student can **start** the registration process. Start times are randomly assigned by a batch process in PeopleSoft. Students may not request a change to their enrollment appointment.

It is critical that each student view their “enrollment appointment” ONLINE as soon as possible to see their “start time”. Students can begin registering for classes only at the start of their enrollment appointment.

Prior to registering, please refer to Cal Maritime Class Priority Guidelines for information regarding Class Requisites.

Priority Registration *(November 16th through November 19th)*

CLASS OF 2009, 2010 *	Monday, November 16 th , see Enrollment Appointment for start time**
CLASS OF 2011 *	Tuesday, November 17 th , see Enrollment Appointment for start time**
CLASS OF 2012 *	Wednesday, November 18 th , see Enrollment Appointment for start time**
CLASS OF 2013 *	Thursday, November 19 th , see Enrollment Appointment for start time**

* The student’s official “class” is the basis used in determining Priority Registration and Enrollment Appointments.

** Enrollment Appointment start times are randomly assigned by a batch process in PeopleSoft. Students may not request a change to their enrollment appointment.

Regular Registration *(November 20th through December 4th)*

Regular registration begins on Friday, November 20th, and ends Friday, December 4th. However, you are encouraged to register at the start of your enrollment appointment to avoid scheduling problems.

(Avoid a \$100 Late Registration Fee by registering no later than December 4th)

Late Registration (\$100 late fee will be charged) *(December 4th through January 15th)*

All continuing cadets are encouraged to register for the Spring 2010 semester no later than Friday, December 4th. Otherwise a **\$100 late registration fee** will be applied to your fee balance. If you do not plan to return in the Spring, please inform the Student Records Office as soon as possible.
