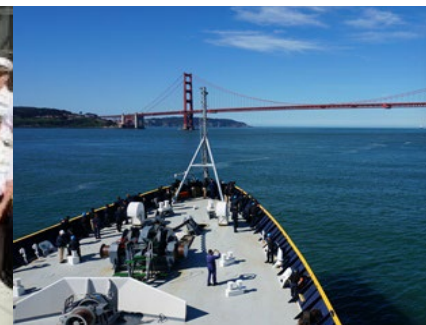
WHAT MAKES US UNIQUE?

Leadership programming is an important opportunity!



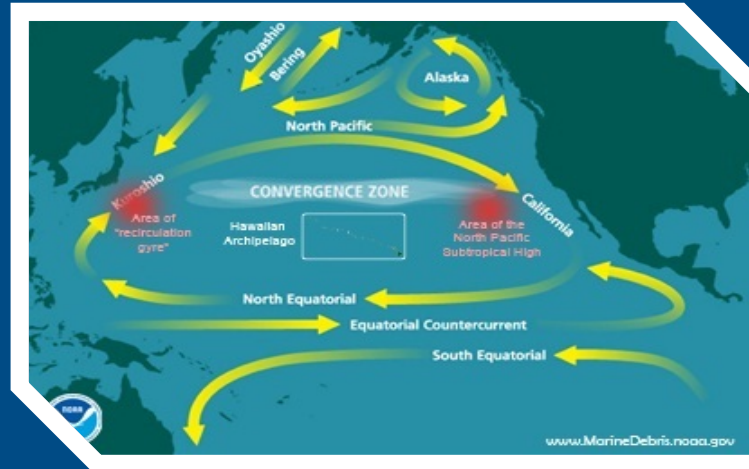
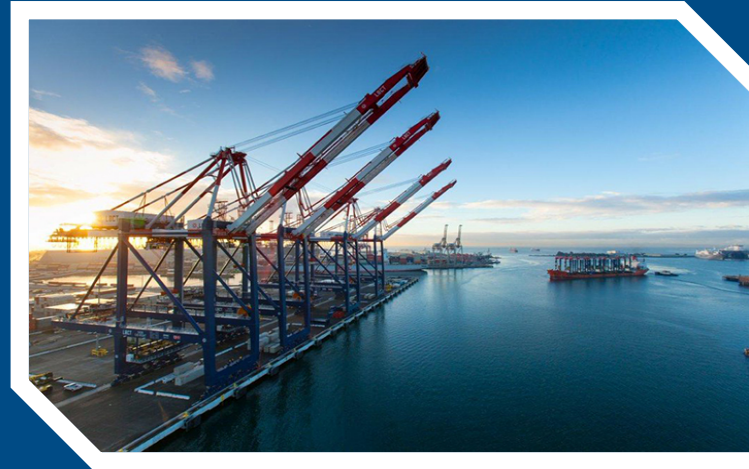
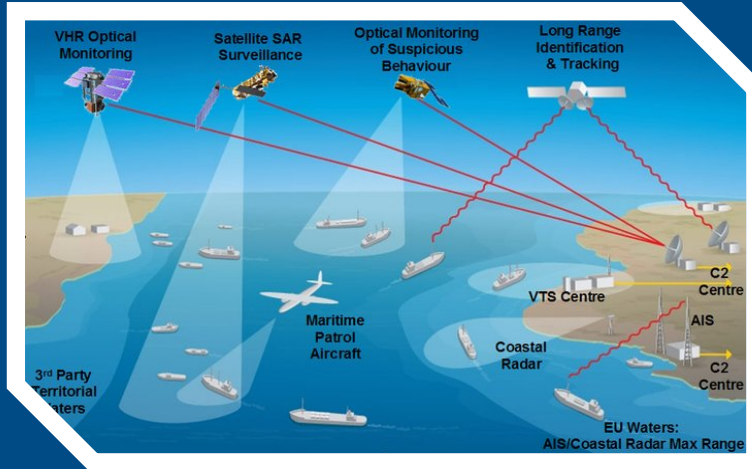
WHAT MAKES US UNIQUE?

Gold Subjects – It's About the Final Course

A.	Social Science	1 Year + 1 Year U.S. History
B.	English	4 Years (8 Semesters)
C.	Mathematics	3 Years Up to Algebra II (4 Years Highly Recommended) <i>Mechanical Engineering Requires Pre-Calculus</i>
D.	Laboratory Science	1 Year Anatomy / Biology / Other 1 Year Chemistry / Physics / Other
E.	Languages Other than English	2 Years of Single Language <i>Includes ASL & Indigenous People's Language</i>
F.	Visual & Performing Arts	1 Year of Single Category
G.	Elective	1 Year of Single Category

HIGH SCHOOL GPA & TEST SCORES



✓ Not Counted in GPA: *All Grade 9 & Non-“A-G” Grade 10-12 Courses*

- GPA can include up to 8 extra points AP, IB, Honors, or College Courses
 - How to repair a low grade or missing course
 - SAT and ACT are not being used in CSU admission evaluation

If CA GPA is 2.00-2.49 or
Out-of-State GPA is 2.47-2.99

- ✓ Grade improvement in 6th and 7th semesters
- ✓ Number of courses beyond minimum in each any A-G category
- ✓ Solano County student
- ✓ Current or prior military service
- ✓ Foster youth, ward of the court, or unaccompanied minor status



 - February 15, 2021 (Transfers)
 - Confirmation of Enrollment Due for All by May 1, 2021



ADMITTED STUDENTS



- \$500 non-refundable deposit due by May 1, 2021
 - Crucial health forms and clearances required for admission
 - Certain health conditions may prevent students in sea-going majors from fulfilling graduation requirements. Check with our Health Center.

SCHOLARSHIPS (NEW STUDENTS)



- **State University Grant (SUG)**

Based on Estimated Financial Contribution (EFC) and Cost of Attendance (COA)

- **Presidential Scholarships**

Full-tuition, four-year, merit-based; selection based on grades, test scores, and an essay application (due January 10)

- **Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) Scholarships**

For all admitted students (except with bachelor degrees) from WUE states and territories; reduces out-of-state tuition from \$19,200 to \$8,600 per year

- **David Lyman Scholarships**

Competitive four-year; for Hawaii residents intending to work on vessels; one new award per year based on application essay and interview in Hawaii (due January 15)



GOAL OF FINANCIAL AID



- **Primary Goal: Assist students in paying for college**
 - Evaluate family's ability to pay using FAFSA
Free Application for Federal Student Aid
 - Distributing limited resources equitably
-

TYPES OF FINANCIAL AID

- **Federal Pell Grant**

- Awarded to undergraduates with greatest need
- Based on EFC
Expected Family Contribution
- Maximum Award: \$6,345

- **Cal Grant A**

- ✓ *Pays CSU tuition*
- ✓ *2020-2021 award: \$5,742*

- **Cal Grant A & B**

- Awarded from State of CA to CA residents
- Based on income/assets
- Minimum GPA
A: 3.0 GPA / B: 2.0 GPA

- **Cal Grant B**

- ✓ *Access award first year, then fees other years*
- ✓ *First year: \$1,656*
- ✓ *After first year: \$5,742 fees + \$1,656*

TYPES OF FINANCIAL AID

- **State University Grant**

- Awarded by the CSU

- Based on EFC

- Expected Family Contribution*

- 2020-2021 Award: \$5,742

- Student must enroll at least half-time*

- Pays mandatory CSU tuition fee



TYPES OF FINANCIAL AID

● Federal Direct Loan *Subsidized*

- Awarded by federal government
- Interest-free while in school
*Interest begins at date of separation
(graduation or withdrawal)*
- 2020-2021 Rate: 2.75%
*1.057% loan fee deducted from loan
disbursement*
- Repayment begins 6 months after
separation date
10 years to repay

● Federal Direct Loan *Unsubsidized*


- Awarded by federal government
- Borrower responsible for interest
*May pay interest while in school or defer until
repayment (interest capitalized into interest)*
- Interest begins at disbursement
*2020-2021 Rate: 2.75%
1.057% loan fee deducted from loan disbursement*
- Repayment begins 6 months after
separation date
10 years to repay

TYPES OF FINANCIAL AID

- **Federal Parent PLUS Loan**
 - Awarded by federal government
 - Requires application & credit check
 - Interest begins at date of disbursement (graduation or withdrawal)*
 - 2020-2021 Rate: 5.30%
 - 4.224% loan fee deducted from loan disbursement*
 - Repayment begins 60 days after last disbursement for spring semester
 - 10 years to repay*

FINANCIAL AID PROCESS



- **Apply through FAFSA and Cal Grant GPA Verification Form**
For CA State Residents
 - **FAFSA priority deadline: March 2nd**
fafsa.gov
 - **Estimate income tax information (if not filed)**
 - **Submit verification documents (if required)**
Priority document deadline: May 1st
 - **Receive award package**

FINANCIAL AID PROCESS



- **Verification**
 - If selected, submit documents
 - Request appears in Student Center “To Do List”
 - Most Common Requests
 - ✓ *Federal IRS tax transcripts*
 - ✓ *Income Verification Form*
 - ✓ *Household size verification*
 - Required before aid awarded
