I am pleased to report that as a result of the hard work and good planning of our COVID-19 task force and the academic leadership team, Cal Maritime received approval from Governor Newsom's office for a limited reopening of our campus to resume face-to-face instruction for the completion of our Spring 2020 semester as planned. This decision was run through the Chancellor's Office and various internal entities of the Governor's Office, including the State Department of Public Health, who provided additional guidance consistent with our current plan.

I met briefly with the Cabinet and asked that they begin working with their respective teams over the next few days to review the plan as it currently stands. Our main effort over the next week is to ensure that we have addressed all critical areas and any remaining concerns. **Additional details will be shared with the campus community early next week.**
