**As of today, we have 0 cadets in offsite isolation, 0 cadets in onsite isolation, one cadet in offsite quarantine, and 0 cadets in onsite quarantine. In addition, we have two employees in isolation and two employees in quarantine.**

#### **What you NEED to know**

- The return plan to date is that all cadets who will be on campus for the Spring 2021 semester will receive COVID testing on January 27. One message has gone out regarding this testing, and more details will be provided with move-in information.
- Free testing is also being made available to all faculty and staff who are anticipating being on campus during the Spring semester. This is one of the most important ways to help keep our community and your families safe. Please do your part.
- Those that return early (prior to January 25) will be required to complete the [daily health check](#) and then will be tested with everyone else.
- This will be the last weekly newsletter until late January
- **We recommend you use California's exposure notification system.** If you go to <https://canotify.ca.gov/> you can activate it on your phone. This system was designed to rapidly identify and inform people who have had close contact (greater than 15 minutes and less than 6 feet) with a person who was determined to be positive for Covid-19. It is a great tool to keep you informed.

#### **Current State Restrictions**

- [Stay at Home Order](#) – Solano County has dropped to 11% of ICU space available, with 15% being the trigger for shelter in place. The shelter in place order has been given and will go into effect as of 11:59 PM, Thursday, December 17. This will not change any Cal Maritime operations from the current levels. You can track this information [here](#).
- [Travel advisories](#) If you are unable to quarantine for 14 days after you travel both to your destination and again upon your return, please **DO NOT TRAVEL**.
- [Curfew](#) – Purple tier regions require people to be home by 10 PM until 5 AM daily, except for essential activities.

The following table represents our testing efforts and results since the summer. We will continue to keep this table updated and include it in our weekly newsletter. As always, we truly appreciate all your efforts and cooperation in helping keep our community safe.

**Isolation** separates sick people with a contagious disease from people who are not sick.

**Quarantine** separates and restricts the movement of people who were exposed to a contagious disease to see if they become sick. In the second column is the # COVID tests administered, and that came back negative in green with positives in red.
