It does feel like a good idea to bring a bunch of students from all over the world back to one campus, let alone on a ship for 50 days, during a time like this. I'm going to be going because I want to graduate a some point in the foreseeable future, but I am worried about it.

Now that we have multiple case studies on how fast the virus spreads on ships (USS Theodore Roosevelt, Diamond Princess, etc.) I'd really like to know the school's plans for mitigating the risk of a Covid infection on the bear. Since it doesn't look like a full quarentine for everyone is feasible, will there be testing?

Please refer to the previous answer. This is grossly irresponsible.

I am a 3 year marine engineer. If I believe my commercial cruise will be cancelled, I am not coming back since I will have to stay an extra year regardless. In fact, I'm going to need more classes to get the minimum 12 units, right now if I stayed an extra year, I would only be taking about 9 units a semester.

Refunds have been a consistent issue and I hope we will get clarity on that issue soon.

What if a student passed away due to this decision, who is to take responsibility? And since the very beginning of this virus, an alternative plan was never released and discussed. The lack of discussion of an alternative plan is not only worrisome it also makes me question the faculty's ability to make proper-unbiased decision with regard to sudden emergence of a catastrophe such as this. In such a turn of events the decisions have to be flexible unlike this one sided persistent method. Never once have I seen a slow down and reconsideration with proper risk evaluation throughout the past few month.
