The Health and Safety Taskforce is pleased to report that 884 members of our Cal Maritime community signed up to receive the Covid-19 vaccination. Each additional person vaccinated will make our community better protected against this disease.

VISITOR SIGN IN PROCESS

For staff and faculty that need to bring consultants, vendors, donors, or other guests to campus, we have rolled out our guest approval process. Thanks to the hard work of Julianne Tolson and Michael Lam, we now have an easy way to request and approve visitors. The request for visitors is available at <https://www.csum.edu/alert/covid-19/>, fill it out, receive approval from the appropriate administrator, and most importantly, enable our guests to be fully informed of the safety measures they must use on campus and complete the daily health screening. A negative COVID test is not required to visit campus.

As of today, we have 0 cadets in offsite isolation, 1 cadet in onsite isolation, 0 cadet in offsite quarantine, and 3 cadets in onsite quarantine. In addition, we have 1 employee in isolation and 8 employees in quarantine.

Random COVID testing continues. Tomorrow we have about 120 cadets, and employees signed up to be tested. If you have been selected, please visit Rizza Lobby between 1000 and 1400.

Isolation separates sick people with a contagious disease from people who are not sick.

Quarantine separates and restricts the movement of people who were exposed to a contagious disease to see if they become sick. In the second column is the # COVID tests administered, and that came back negative in green with positives in red.
