Dear Cal Maritime community,

Thank you to those who participated in the first weekly on-campus COVID-19 testing yesterday. As a reminder, ALL cadets and employees that come to campus must be fully vaccinated or have an approved accommodation. Anyone not fully vaccinated or not verified through Peoplesoft is required to be COVID-19 tested weekly. Additionally, any member of the Cal Maritime community can be tested voluntarily by signing up ahead of time at covid19hs@csum.edu. Thirty-nine cadets and five employees were tested yesterday. Student Affairs will contact cadets that were notified and did not participate in testing. Employees that were notified and did not participate in testing will be referred to Human Resources and their Appropriate Administrator for further action.

Testing is scheduled EVERY Tuesday from Noon to 2 PM in the front room of the Technology Center near the large brass impeller along Maritime Academy Drive. Cadets and employees subject to mandatory testing do not require an appointment but should rather attend testing during the time period above.

The following represents our testing efforts and results for the month of August. It also includes any external results that have been submitted. Yesterday's testing is in process and will be reported next week.

Isolation separates sick people with a contagious disease from people who are not sick. Normally, isolated people are released (cleared) in ten days from onset.

Quarantine separates and restricts the movement of people exposed to a contagious disease to see if they become sick. Fully vaccinated individuals are not required to guarantine unless they develop symptoms, then they will be tested and cleared or isolated

if positive.

The second column shows the # COVID tests administered with negative results indicated in green and positive in red.

Please ensure you are fully registered at https://avellinocov2.com/ PRIOR to testing on campus.

Everyone must complete the daily health check if coming to campus.

Everyone must wear a mask over the face and nose in all indoor campus facilities, whether vaccinated or not.

While we do not require proof of vaccination for on-campus events at this time, if you are fully vaccinated, we recommend you visit https://myvaccinerecord.cdph.ca.gov/ to obtain your non-expiring COVID-19 QR code to ensure that you can provide proof anytime.

We continue to add information to the <u>COVID website</u> and encourage cadets to share this information with family and provide feedback on any additional information that would be useful to the community.
