Thank you to those who participated in the weekly on-campus COVID-19 testing yesterday.

Testing is scheduled EVERY Tuesday from Noon to 2 PM in the front room of the Technology Center near the large brass impeller along Maritime Academy Drive. Cadets and employees subject to mandatory testing do not require an appointment but should rather attend testing during the time period above. If you are required to be tested weekly and do not attend on-campus testing MUST provide weekly negative test results from an approved testing facility. Home test results are not accepted.

Any member of the Cal Maritime community can participate voluntarily by signing up ahead of time at covid19hs@csum.edu.

Please ensure you are fully registered at <https://avellinocov2.com/> PRIOR to testing on campus.

The following represents our testing efforts and results to date this semester. It also includes any external results that have been submitted. Yesterday's testing is in process and will be reported next week.

Isolation separates sick people with a contagious disease from people who are not sick. Normally, isolated people are released (cleared) in ten days from onset.

Quarantine separates and restricts the movement of people exposed to a contagious disease to see if they become sick. Fully vaccinated individuals are not required to quarantine unless they develop symptoms, then they will be tested and cleared or isolated

if positive.

The second column shows the # COVID tests administered with negative results indicated in green and positive in red.

Everyone must complete the daily health check if coming to campus.

Everyone must wear a mask over the nose and mouth in all indoor campus facilities, whether vaccinated or not.

While we do not require proof of vaccination for on-campus events at this time, if you are fully vaccinated, we recommend you visit <https://myvaccinerecord.cdph.ca.gov/> to obtain your non-expiring COVID-19 QR code to ensure that you can provide proof anytime.
