Locations for receiving COVID boosters, which are now widely available, can be found through https://www.vaccines.gov/. They are available at local pharmacies by appointment (and some walk-in) and through on a walk-in basis. As with the initial injections, it takes about 15 days before they are fully effective. Therefore we strongly urge you to schedule your booster immediately so it can be in full force before traveling for the Thanksgiving holiday. If you schedule a booster nearby and need help with transportation, please contact the Commandant's office.

Everyone should carry reusable masks with them, but if you forget, masks should be available in each classroom. If any classroom is low in disinfectant, sanitizer or masks, please place a work order using the QR code in most classrooms or go to https://csum.metabim.com/login/Welcome.htm

This week's testing showed once again that we currently have no positive cases on campus.

Isolation separates sick people with a contagious disease from people who are not sick. Normally, isolated people are released (cleared) in ten days from onset.

Quarantine separates and restricts the movement of people exposed to a contagious disease to see if they become sick. Fully vaccinated individuals are not required to quarantine unless they develop symptoms, then they will be tested and cleared or isolated if positive.

The second column shows the # of COVID tests administered, with negative results indicated in green and positive in red.

Everyone must complete the daily health check if coming to campus.

Everyone must wear a mask over the nose and mouth in all indoor campus facilities, whether vaccinated or not.

We continue to add information to the <u>COVID website</u> and encourage cadets to share this information with family and provide feedback on any additional information that would be useful to the community.
