SUBJECT: Campus Masking Requirements

Beginning Monday, March 07, 2022, Cal Maritime will lift the mandate for wearing masks indoors for fully vaccinated and boosted individuals. This is based on continued reduction in regional COVID rates, our high percentage of fully vaccinated Keelhaulers, and weekly testing program results.

The COVID-19 program will:

- Require completion of the Daily Health check
- Require weekly testing and masking of those who are unvaccinated and those not up to date with COVID-19 vaccinations (including boosters)
- Offer voluntary PCR testing for anyone on campus during the weekly surveillance testing
- Make masks available for use across campus
- Require masks in The Student Health Center, and mass transit.
- Support community members who choose to continue masking
- Require masking indoors for a minimum of 10 days after a positive COVID test or close contact with a known COVID positive person.

Cal Maritime continues to closely monitor COVID-19 metrics on campus and in the region to make the best decisions possible in support of our academic mission and the safety of our campus community. Masks and other safety measures may be reimplemented based on future conditions.
