The Disability Services Office (DSO) is committed to supporting the academic success of Cal Maritime's students with disabilities. We provide support services and serve as an informational resource to individual students with disabilities and to the entire campus community. At Cal Maritime, the Disability Services Office operates as part of the Student Engagement & Academic Success (SEAS) Center.

In order to receive any services or accommodations, a student must establish a documented physical, psychological or learning disability. Each category has its own standard for documentation, but all disabilities must be substantiated by a licensed professional in the field. Contacting our offices early to compile the required documentation is key. Please note additional documentation, beyond an existing IEP and/or 504 Plan, may be required for a comprehensive review.
