Advice Section - Career Fair

As always, doing research on the companies attending when we release the program is paramount. There will be returning companies you might want to refresh on or check out specific opportunities they might be offering, but there will also be new companies who you will want to engage with. Make sure you learn as much as you can about them beforehand, so you are prepared to have intelligent and relevant conversations with them at the event.

The other aspect to making the Career Fair a meaningful event is building confidence in discussing your goals, skills, and interests. This is more challenging than the research portion, as you need to combine self-analysis and actualization, how a company could fit your vision, and adaptability to unscripted conversations. There are multiple ways to prep for this, including personal introspection and practice, discussing with friends and mentors, and meeting with Career Services to role play these conversations. By putting in effort to prep for these upcoming conversations, you can become more comfortable and receive feedback and advice on to how to make these impactful.
