Advice Section – Career Fair Follow Ups

With the Career Fair now in the rearview mirror, it's time to make those connections you made count. Whether you were discussing open jobs and internships, catching up with a company rep that you have met before, or gathering general information to better understand a company, to build this connection into a meaningful professional network, you will have to put in some work.

Easiest way to start this is by sending out emails to the representatives you met. In these emails, you can include a thank you, highlight something you discussed at the career fair, both directly career related and person, when possible, and a promise for future connection. Depending on your conversation, you can also include your resume in the email or any other relevant information you might have discussed. The goal here is to build on the progress you made from the in-person meeting and show your interest and enthusiasm for the connection, the company, and the potential position.

From here, the work begins to develop this connection from a one-time meeting into a professional relationship that helps you in all endeavors of your career process. This will take both time and diligence on your part to maintain communication over the months. This is not something that you need to be doing weekly, or even monthly, but periodic check-ins and updates will keep you fresh on the representative's mind. Further, as new career and job questions pop up, you will have a trusted resource into either the company or career in general. Build these connections and this network over time and looking for jobs and furthering your career will become easier.
