While stationed at ANT Kennewick, LT Hamann struck Machinery Technician, earned an A.A. in Criminal Justice and applied to the College Student Pre Commissioning Initiative (CSPI). After applying to CSPI, she attended Marine Science Technician (MST) "A" School and graduated in March 2015.

Following graduation from MST "A", she was selected as a primary candidate for CSPI. She attended Mercy College in Manhattan, NY from 2015-2017 where she earned her B.S. in Corporate and Homeland Security Management. Following college graduation, she attended 17 weeks of Officer Candidate School in New London, CT.

Her officer tours include: Marine Safety Unit Houma, Houma LA as an Apprentice Marine Inspector (2017-2020), Sector Puget Sound, Seattle, WA as a Journeyman Marine Inspector and Chief of Domestics (2020-2023) and is currently stationed at Sector San Francisco in the Waterways Management Division.
