EOP Priorities AY 2022-2023

- 1. Enhance program services to expand resources and support for EOP students
 - **Goal**: increase marketing and promotional strategies for EOP Loan Forgiveness service to support seniors and juniors in both Fall 2022 and Spring 2023
 - **Goal:** collaborate with Basic Needs resource department on campus to increase outreach and visibility of basic needs resources to EOP students, particularly around food insecurity and Cal Fresh support
 - **Goal**: develop a comprehensive policy for EOP Housing Stipend (for on-campus housing support) in collaboration with Financial Aid department, CARE Team, Residence Life, etc.
- 2. Increase engagement with EOP juniors and seniors through leadership opportunities and career readiness
 - **Goal:** provide opportunities for juniors and seniors to connect with freshman and sophomores on academic major support and divisional leadership within the Corps
 - **Goal:** increase participation and engagement of juniors and seniors by providing a wide-range of benefits and resources (Loan Forgiveness, workshop requirements, etc.)
 - **Goal:** partner with Career Services to provide intentional workshop and programming to support first-generation college students entering the workforce
- 3. Provide higher level of DEI-focused programming to enhance sense of belonging
 - **Goal**: partner with key DEI campus groups (Chief Diversity Officer department, DEI Council, Inclusion Center) to provide learning opportunities and workshops
 - **Goal**: develop a strong partnership between EOP Peer Mentors and Peer Equity Leaders through leadership development and DEI programming
- 4. Develop EOP programming and resources to improve academic support services
 - **Goal**: develop an 'academic success plan' with intrusive interventions and accountability structure for students on academic probation
 - **Goal**: partner with University Advisors for comprehensive support plan with "atrisk" EOP students (academic probation, mental health challenges, basic needs, etc.)
 - **Goal:** collaborate with new Academic Student Support Coordinator (Dr. Erika Nelson) to provide hands-on instructional support (EOP study night with tutors, tutoring workshops, etc.) for EOP students
