1. Call to Order

2. Senate Chair Announcements

- After the discussion, *the Senate agreed to form a Senate task force that will review these issues, document them, and draft a resolution to be reviewed by the full Senate.*
- *Another closed meeting prior to the end of the semester was proposed.* The proposal was met with general agreement. The date and agenda is to be determined, so the meeting will be formalized with the requisite vote at a General Senate meeting later this spring semester.
