New Business –

Tim Westmoreland – raised the topic of the desire for cameras in general public areas throughout housing to assist in deterring crime and vandalism through the ability to review recorded data. The cameras would be posted as no live monitoring.

Craig Dawson—Facilities is working with the Chancellor's Office to fund and develop designs to repair leaning pathway bulkheads between the Lower and Upper Residence, including Lower Residence Road and the stairway between the Upper Residence and Bodner Field area.

Kristen Bautista—A cadet experienced failing wooden chairs in the dorms, and staples were starting to poke through. A Work Order was placed with Sodexo, and the cadet was encouraged not to use seating and to communicate directly with Housing to ensure repairs were made.

Craig Dawson—The ADA access button at the Bistro is not working due to the left door being locked, and it requires further evaluation and repair.

Tim Westmoreland – Housing is working to develop guidance for professional Staff and student coordinators related to First-Aid, evacuation protocols, responding to different incidents, including potential vomit or blood. Housing to coordinate with EH&S in developing.
